

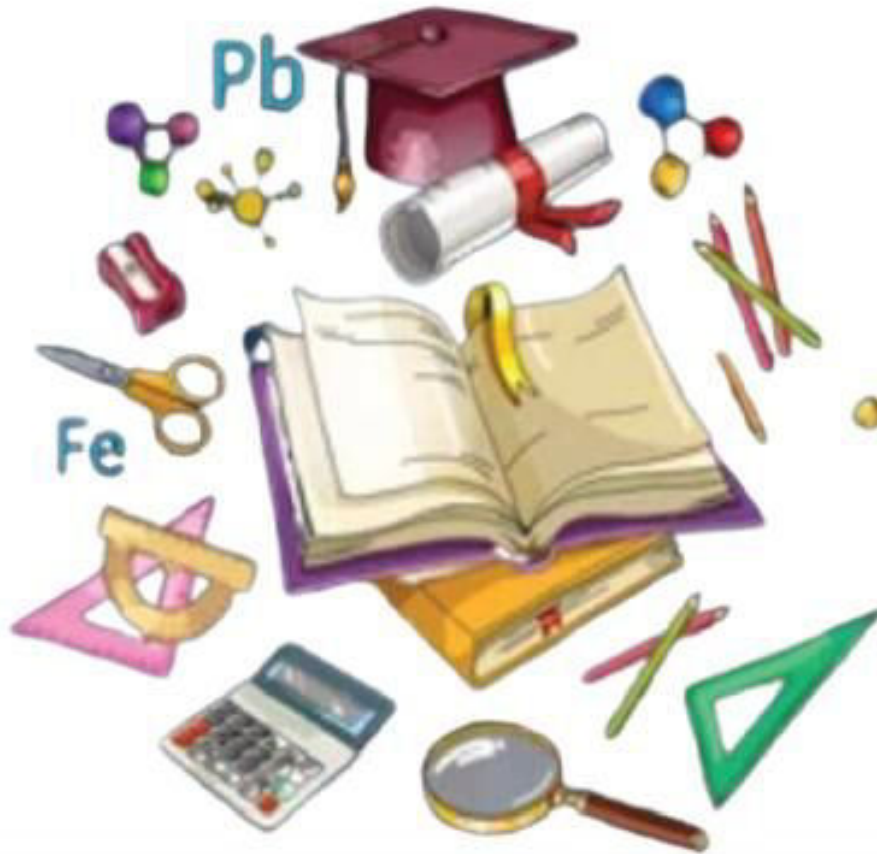

REMEMBER

- We require at least three days for processing applications for any official documents and certificates.
- No changes in Leaving Certificate will be entertained in school while seeking admission in primary, secondary or higher secondary section.
- Records will strictly be entered as per the L.C. of the previous school.

VISION

We believe in providing quality education to our students so as to ensure all-round development of the child by actively engaging them in academic learning, sports and extra curricular activities that will mould our students to be academically strong, holistically developed, culturally aware of our values and ethics and develop them into individuals who can be responsible citizens with humanitarian attitude.

MISSION

Samarpan Public School is a completely secular institution that instills among its students utmost respect for our rich cultural heritage and a deep sense of regard for the values upheld by our Constitution. To instill social virtues such as equality, tolerance, brotherhood, service, sympathy and liberty in the learner.

SYLLABUS

The school is affiliated to Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi and caters education to all students through innovative pedagogies. The course of studies is planned to lead up to the Secondary and Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination.

CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE SCHOOL

WORKING DAYS

For the students :

The school will work for six days in a week i.e. Monday to Saturday. (Except 2nd & 4th Saturday)

For School Staff :

The school staff will work for six days in a week i.e. Monday to Saturday.

SCHOOL TIMINGS

The timings for students: - 7:30 a.m. to 1:10 p.m. from Monday to Friday.

On 1st & 3rd Saturdays timings will be 7.30 a.m. to 11.30 a.m.

Projects and assignment work should be completed at home. Students may be asked to attend the school for activities or guided projects, by prior notice, on Saturdays.

MEETING THE PRINCIPAL

The parents can meet the Principal on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with prior appointment.

Timings:- 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.

CORRESPONDENCE WITH THE SCHOOL

For any correspondence with the school, the parent / guardian should write an application and submit at the school reception. Prior appointment is compulsory to meet the Principal.

SCHOOL OFFICE HOURS

School office hours:- 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. from Monday to Friday.

Saturday timings:- 8:00 am to 12:30 pm.

On Sundays the school office remains closed and no school business will be conducted.

Note :- The processing of any document such as certificates, bonafide etc requires atleast seven working days. The parents are therefore requested to submit a written application for any of these, in advance.

Parents are requested to co-operate & come to deposit the school fees during the school office hours only. Fees will not be taken after office hours. If payment is to be made directly in bank, please collect bank details from the school office.

MEETING WITH THE TEACHERS

Parents will be permitted to meet the teaching staff only on Saturdays. Parents should confirm an appointment with the teacher so that the teacher remains present for the meeting without fail. Parents will not be permitted to meet teachers during other working days. The parents will not be permitted to go to the classes directly or visit the school premises during school hours. This is to prevent any kind of disturbance during school hours.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students must bring the almanac to school everyday. Parents must compulsorily go through the school almanac carefully, for any communication from school.
2. Students must reach the school at least five minutes before the school bell rings.
3. Every student should come to school in complete & proper school uniform as prescribed by the school including tidy hair, nails, shoes and socks. Students will not be allowed in the school premises without complete school uniform.
4. Regular attendance in school is a must. Leave will be granted only for valid reasons, with a prior written note from parent. A medical certificate should be compulsorily submitted in case of illness. (Note: For the security of student half day leave will not be granted unless emergency.)
5. It is mandatory for every student to attend all school activities like games, drill, visits etc.. For exemption from any of the activities, a medical certificate should be submitted in the school.
6. Students will not be allowed to leave the classroom without the permission of the teacher in class.
7. During school hours, students will not be permitted to leave the school premises without the permission of the Principal or Co-ordinator.
8. The students will not be allowed to attend phone calls during class hours. The parent can leave the message for the student at the school reception.
9. Mobile phones should not be brought to school. They are strictly prohibited.
10. The students must not bring any money to school without the permission of the school authorities.
11. Valuable articles like mobile phones, jewellery, i-pods, watches, cameras, tape recorders etc should be avoided by the student in school premises. The school shall not be responsible if such articles are lost on campus.
12. Only text books and school library books are permitted in the school premises. Books and other belongings should be marked with name and class.
13. Every student must respect the school property. Any student responsible for damage to school property, will be charged for the damages and the caution money shall be forfeited.
14. Students should maintain discipline in the school bus. In case of any indiscipline, the student will be barred from using the school bus.
15. No student shall be permitted to use a two wheeler unless he/she submits a written consent letter from the parent.
16. Parents and guardians must not visit their wards or their teacher in the classroom during school hours.
17. Parent should attend the PTM and the Result Declaration without fail.

18. The students should not use any unfair means in examination. Any student found using unfair means, will be barred from the examination.
 19. Homework & assignments are an important part of the school curriculum. Students should be regular & systematic in doing it. Guardians should also assist their wards with their homework /assignment.
 20. No party or demonstration should be held by the students in school premises during school hours unless permitted by the Principal.
 21. The school holds the right to dismiss any student in case of any of the following; inappropriate behaviour, lack of progress in study, over-age, lack of interest on the part of parent or breach of the school rules.
 22. A student whose name has been struck off the rolls will have to take a re-admission which will be solely at the discretion of the school authorities. The student will have to pay the admission fees & will also have to complete the other necessary procedures.
 23. Any issue pertaining to school function &/or activity should be brought to the notice of the school authorities in the form of a written application. This application can be submitted at the school reception. The matter will be addressed and rectified thereafter.
 24. Kindly receive calls from school promptly or get back at the earliest on number given in the Almanac.

LIBRARY RULES

1. Silence must be strictly observed in the library.
2. The library will function from Monday to Friday, during school hours.
3. The library books will be issued by the librarian only.
4. Every student is responsible for maintenance of the library material. Library material can be taken out with the permission of the librarian.
5. Books will be issued only for the students and teachers.
6. Books cannot be kept for more than a week & can be renewed with the permission of the librarian.
7. Fine of Rs. one a day will be charged in case of failure to return the book on expiry date.
8. Library books and materials should be handled with care. In case of any damage, the student responsible will have to pay for the damage done.
9. Reference books cannot be taken out of the library.
10. All books must be returned before the beginning of examinations, before the beginning of vacations & before seeking a leaving certificate, otherwise a fine equivalent to the value of the book would be charged.
11. Students should not exchange books amongst themselves, without the permission of the librarian and if found guilty, he/she would be penalized.
12. Every rule and regulation should be followed unflinchingly.
13. Bags and eatables are not allowed in the library.

SUSPENSION / DISMISSAL / TERMINATION :

School reserves the right to suspend, dismiss or terminate a student if he / she :

1. Fails to show diligence and satisfactory progress in studies.
2. Indulges in immoral behaviour, insubordination, contempt of authority or violation of the student's code of conduct, copying in examinations or causing willful damage to school property or any other unlawful act.
3. Any student suffering from sickness or disease which in the opinion of the school will be harmful or contagious to other students.
4. In case of continuous absence for three months, student's name will be automatically struck off from the school record.
5. Irregular attendance, habitual idleness, disobedience or defiance of authority or conduct injurious to the moral tone of the school are sufficient reasons for the dismissal of a student.

The decision of the school authorities is final and binding.

RULES FOR PAYMENT OF FEES

- (1) Parents are requested to read the rules for payment of fees carefully. School fees can be paid in two terms only. The first term fees can be paid along with the admission fees at the time of admission.

- (2) The fees should be paid on or before the due date of every term.
- (3) After the due date, a late fee of Rs. 10 will be charged from 31st of the month. Until the payment of the fees.
- (4) Fees can be paid at the fee counter of the school office during the school hours on all working days as per the timings given.
- (5) Payment of fees can be done in cheque, cash & online.
- (6) In case of online payment, **Screenshot** of payment receipt should be sent to the school number : **90812 62233** for verification
- (7) During payment of fees by cheque, parent should be careful to fill in the details correctly. In case a cheque is not honoured, an additional fine of Rs. 300 will be charged.

ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWALS

1. Students are generally admitted at the beginning of a term.
2. Admission Process followed by the school is mentioned below.
 - Grade KG to 2nd Personal Meeting with both parents and ward.
 - Grade 3rd to 6th Students entering grade 3 - 6 will be required to take a diagnostic test.
 - Grade 7th to 10th Students entering grade 7 - 10 will be required to undertake an entrance examination in both English and Mathematics.
3. The principal reserves the right to admit or refuse any admission without allocating reasons for the decision.
4. For a student joining the school in KG section for the first time, a photo copy of the birth certificate must be submitted to support the date of birth entered in the admission form. The original birth certificate should be shown for verification.
5. Any admission, 2nd standard onwards, is incomplete until the leaving certificate from the previous recognized school is produced. (In case of an out state student the leaving certificate should be countersigned by the education inspector of the state).
6. A leaving certificate will not be issued unless applied for by the parent or guardian in writing and all dues cleared.
7. Fees remain due as long as the pupil name remains on the roll. In case School Leaving Certificate is issued in the mid session a penalty of Rs.500/- will be charged. Time for issuing School Leaving Certificate is 15 days.
8. To prepare a duplicate leaving certificate an affidavit needs to be produced.
9. Application for leaving certificate must be given in writing along with all necessary information.
10. Lack of attendance, disobedience, defiance of authority, harmful conduct will be bona fide reasons for dismissal from school.
11. The students' behaviour both in & outside the school premises should be appropriate, if found inappropriate he/she will be liable to dismissal, suspension/rustication from school.
12. Notice of withdrawals or any other certificates must be given in writing by the parent/guardian in the prescribed form atleast 7 days in advance.
13. School form fee, admission fee & term fee are not refundable under any circumstances.
14. In case of transfer the order should be submitted along with L.C. application.
15. In any case of withdrawal the refund of tuition fees will be subject to the school management decision.

EXAMINATIONS AND PROMOTIONS

1. There will be Four main examinations i.e. PT-I, Half yearly PT- II and Annual Examination.
2. No pupil will be allowed to remain absent during any examination, except, in case of genuine health problem, in this case, a Medical Certificate must be produced. It should invariably be accompanied by a covering letter from the parent indicating the full name, class and section of the student concerned and submitted to the school.
3. In case of illness during the final examination, the promotion will be decided on the basis of the performance in the half yearly examinations. There will be no re-examination at a later date.
4. Willful breach of any examination rules &/or any dishonesty resorted to, is punishable with suspension from the examination, cancellation of the paper, or dismissal from the school, depending upon the gravity of the offence.
5. Parents are expected to accept the decision of the school authorities regarding promotions as final.

RULES FOR USING SCHOOL TRANSPORT

1. Students will form a queue on the left side of the bus stop.
2. The buses will not wait for students coming late.
3. No movement in the bus is allowed except when the bus comes to a complete halt.
4. Bus should be respected as school property & every student will be responsible for its maintenance.
5. Cost of any damage done to the bus will have to be borne by the student who is responsible.
6. Bus drivers should not be instructed to stop at other, than nominated stops.
7. Courteous behaviour with any one is expected both from students & parents. Anybody found misbehaving will be immediately deprived of bus facility.
8. Any complaint should be given or sent in writing to the school office instead of settling/ quarreling at the bus stop.
9. Students should be accompanied by parents or guardian, to / from the bus. If not so the parent will sign a consent slip provided by the school.
